**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO TEXT OF REGULATION**

**SPECIAL INVESTIGATIVE UNITS**

**November 6, 2019**

**REG-2018-00023**

On July 19, 2019 the Insurance Commissioner issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, proposing to adopt amendments to Title 10, California Code of Regulations (“CCR”), Chapter 5, Subchapter 9, Article 2, sections 2698.30 and 2698.33-2698.41: “Special Investigative Units.”

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF AMENDED TEXT**

**PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED**

The Commissioner proposes to make additional changes to Sections 2698.30, 2698.33, 2698.36, 2698.37, and 2698.39 of the proposed regulation, and now solicits written comments on only those changes. The Commissioner believes the changes made are sufficiently related to the original text such that the public was adequately placed on notice that the change could result from the originally proposed regulatory action. Accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section 11346.8(c), the Commissioner is soliciting written public comments on these changes.

A copy of the proposed sections to be revised, with the proposed changes clearly indicated, is attached to this Notice, and will be available for public inspection and comment for at least 15 days before the proposed regulation is adopted. Deletions made pursuant to the July 19, 2019 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking are shown in ~~striketrough~~; additions made pursuant to the July 19, 2019 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking are shown in underline.
