DWC Announces Public Meeting to Discuss Creation of Workers' Compensation Drug Formulary and Related Rules

The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) invites interested members of the public to discuss the adoption and implementation of a drug formulary. The meeting is scheduled from 10 a.m. until noon on Wednesday, February 17, in the auditorium of the Elihu Harris State Office Building, 1515 Clay Street, Oakland, CA 94612.

Assembly Bill 1124, which became effective January 1, 2016, requires the adoption of a workers' compensation formulary by July 1, 2017. The overarching goal of the formulary and related rules is to expeditiously provide high quality evidence-based care to injured workers while minimizing administrative burden and cost. DWC will facilitate public discussion on how best to achieve the goal, including the following:

- Design of the formulary (how to maximize evidence-based drug selection and transparency)
- Integration of the formulary with existing Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule
- Adoption of rules to improve the efficiency of utilization review, including ways to reduce the need for elevated utilization review and independent medical review
