DWC Issues 15-day Notice for Modifications to Proposed Electronic Document Filing and Lien Filing Fee Rules

The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) has posted a 15-day notice of modification to the electronic document filing and lien filing fee rules to the DWC website. Members of the public are invited to present written comments regarding the proposed modifications to <u>dwcrules@dir.ca.gov</u> until 5 p.m. on September 11.

The proposed modifications include:

- Revisions to the definitions of the terms "cost," "party," and "section 4903(b) lien"
- Adding a new section that sets forth when lien filing or activation fee refunds will automatically take place and provides a procedure for requesting lien fee refunds. Additionally, the regulations include a new form that must be used to request the lien fee refund.
- Revisions to the EAMS reference guide and instructional manual and the JET File Business Rules and Technical Specifications.
