Good morning, everyone. My name is MR. CORTES: John Cortes. I'm an Industrial Relations Counsel for the 3 Division of Workers' Compensation. Before we begin today's conference call public hearing, I want to inform everyone that this call is being recorded. I want to inform everyone that --7 I want to ask if anyone wishes to make a public comment today, and if you do, can you please give us your full name, the organization you're affiliated with, if any, and contact information in case we need to provide you with any updates. We prefer an email address, but if you don't have an email address, your phone number or mailing address would be fine. 13 Maureen Gray, who I mentioned earlier, the DWC Regulations Coordinator, who is also on this call, will write down your 15 name and your contact information right now.

So does anyone wish to make a public comment today? Please let me know -- let us know. We're going to give this a second. Again, does anyone wish to make a public comment today? Okay. So far no one has indicated that they are going to be giving a public comment today, but someone could change their mind during the hearing and wish to speak, so I will give everyone an opportunity to make a public comment. So after I finish my comments, I will once again ask if anyone wishes to make a public comment. Okay.

So before I begin, I want to ask everyone to press

their respective mute button to minimize unintended background noises. Please press unmute when you wish to speak and please make sure to state your name before you begin speaking for our hearing reporter. Okay.

I'm going to go ahead and get started. Thank you for participating today. Again, I'm John Cortes, an Industrial Relations Counsel for the Division of Workers' Compensation.

This is our noticed conference call public hearing for the evidence-based update to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule, also known as the M-T-U-S. The Division is proposing to make an "evidence-based update" to the MTUS by adopting the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine, or ACOEM's Anti-Emetics Guideline.

Now, I'd like to take a moment to introduce the other DWC staff members on this conference call today. As I've mentioned, I'm joined by Maureen Gray, the Division's Regulations Coordinator; also on the call is George Parisotto, the DWC's Administrative Director; in addition, we have Yvonne Hauscarriague, the DWC Legal Unit's Chief Counsel; and, finally, joining us is Dr. Raymond Meister, the DWC's Executive Medical Director. Again, our hearing reporter is Sonia Garcia.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments on the proposed amendment to the regulations, and we welcome any comments you have about them. Please note, we will not question, respond to, or discuss anyone's comments, although we

may ask for clarification or ask you to elaborate further on any points that you are presenting. All of your comments, both given verbally here today and those submitted in writing, will be considered in determining what revisions, if any, we make to the proposed regulations.

Please restrict the subject of your comments to the proposed regulations. And usually we ask that you limit your comments to three minutes in length. However, since it doesn't appear that we have anyone yet who has signed up to speak, if anyone wishes to speak, we will allow -- we will go ahead and allow you to go beyond the normal three-minute time limit.

I will call the names of those who have indicated they wish to testify today. If anyone does wish to testify, and I apologize in advance if I mispronounce the names, all testimony today will be taken down by the hearing reporter.

When everyone on this list has had a chance to make a public comment, I'll check to see if anybody new has joined our call who wants to speak or if anyone has additional comments. This hearing will continue for as long as there are people who wish to comment on the proposed evidence regulations, but it will close at 5:00 o'clock this afternoon. It's likely not going to go that long. All right. So if the hearing continues, again likely not to go that long, if it continues into the lunch hour, we will take an hour break.

Finally, all written comments can be submitted by fax

at the following number (510) 286-0657 or to the following email address, all lower case, dwcrules@dir.ca.gov. Comments submitted by fax or by email will be accepted until midnight tonight.

So if you don't give a verbal comment today or during this public comment hearing or -- hearing, then you can always submit a comment by midnight tonight via fax or email. Those who did not wish to speak today but want to be notified of any subsequent changes or of the final adaptation of the update, please provide your complete name and email address to the same address mentioned above, again all lower case, dwcrules@dir.ca.gov. Any notice of changes and the final notice to the evidence-based update to the MTUS will be sent to everyone who requests that information.

With that, does anyone wish to give a public comment today? Again, I'm going to give this a second or two to see if anyone on this phone call wishes to speak. Anyone? Is that someone unmuting? Okay.

Well, if we do not have anyone who wishes to make a verbal comment today, the time is 10:09, and this public hearing is now closed. Thank you very much.
